

## COURSE DESCRIPTION

To provide participants with the skills and knowledge required to provide first aid response, life support, management of casualty(s), the incident and other first aiders, in a range of situations, including in the home, workplace or within the community, until the arrival of medical or other assistance

## COURSE CONTENT

This course contains the following learning content:

HLTAID003 – Provide first aid

- Legal and other requirements
- Basic life support (DRSABCD), CPR and AED
- Range of common injuries covering eye and ear, burns, abdominal, wounds and musculoskeletal
- Cardiac conditions, stroke and respiratory distress, including asthma
- Allergic reaction, anaphylaxis and seizures/Convulsions
- Choking and airway obstruction, shock management and unconsciousness
- Envenomation, poisoning and toxic substances
- Diabetes
- Drowning
- Extremes of heat and cold
- Head, neck and spinal injuries

## COURSE REQUIREMENTS

Participants are required to have the following:

*Materials -*

- Pens/pencils
- Photo ID

*Clothing –*

- Wear normal work clothes including
  - Covered footwear (steel capped boots preferred)
  - Long sleeve shirt

Long pants or overalls

- Respond to an emergency situation
- Apply appropriate first aid procedures
- Communicate details of the incident
- Evaluate the incident and own performance?
